Cross Curricular Project

College Ready. Career Ready.

Twelve students are hard at work for a 5 week cross curricular project that touches on the major subject areas studied at Liguori Academy. The project kicked off with students selecting a piece of literature from an approved list. Once they finish their book, students will have to

complete the following:

1. Respond to a literature-centric prompt regarding their chosen text in 500 words.
2. Write a 1,000 word term paper discussing the historical relevance of the text based on prompts specific to each.
3. Select a building, object or structure from the text. Using K'Nex, students will construct their build, and then use mathematical formula to scale the build up to actual size. Concurrently, using the scientific method, they will describe the trial and error necessary to create their build.
4. Students will use assorted art supplies to create the outer shell of their selected build in as perfect detail as possible, and apply it to the K'Nex framework.

In the final week, Students will pull all of their work together into a PowerPoint presentation. The presentations will touch on the literature they selected and how they worked through each step. We look forward to see what the students have to present!
